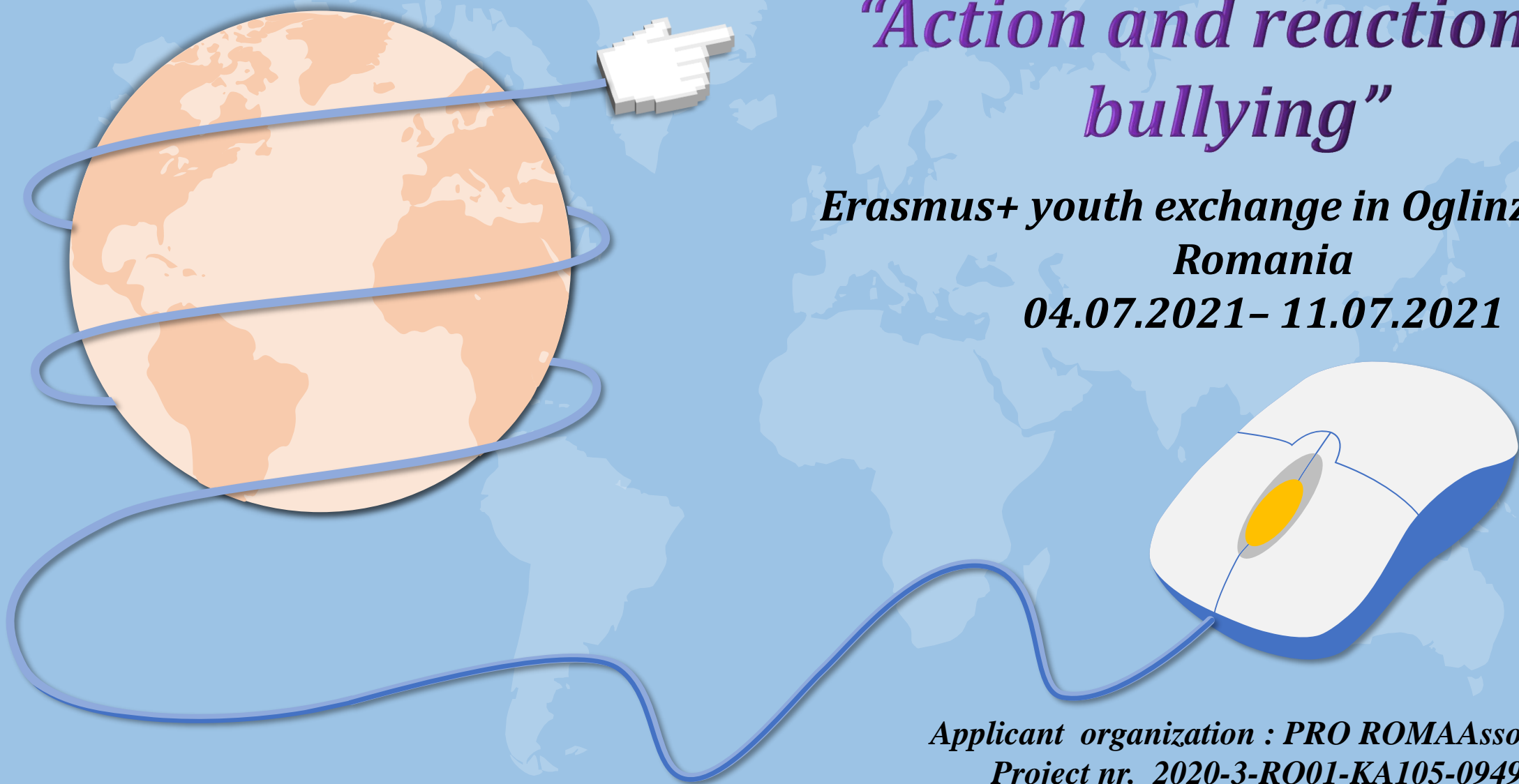

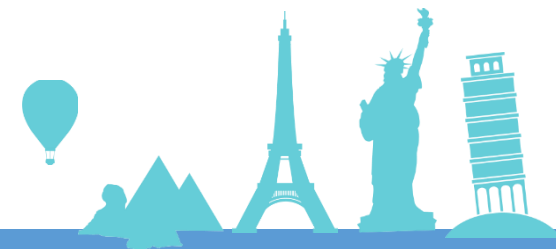

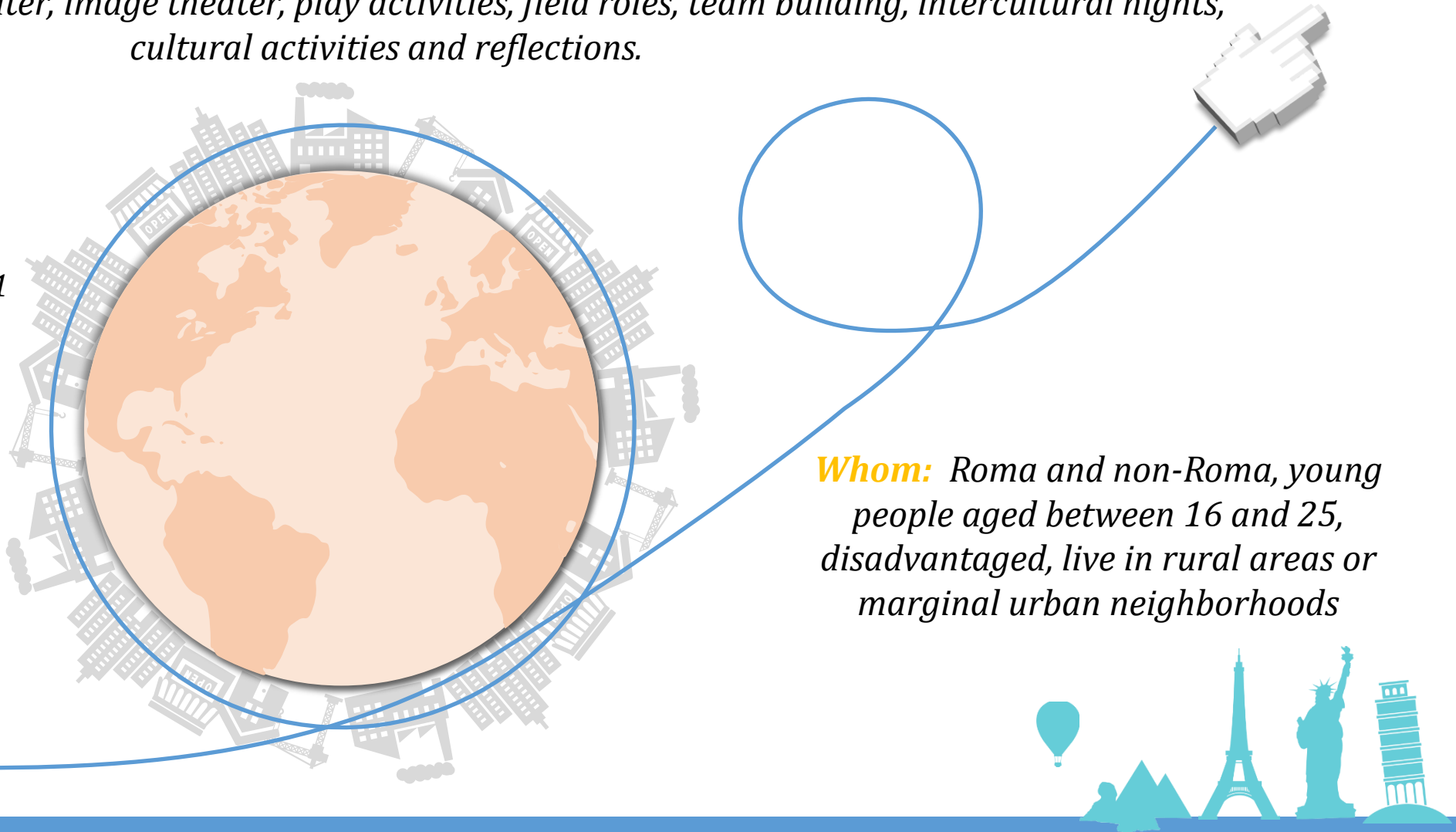


A few words about the mobility

Promote your country through the camera lens!, is a youth exchange that brings together 42 participants (36 young people and 6 group leaders) from 6 countries: Spain, Turkey, Poland, Bulgaria, Croatia and Romania. During eight working days, daily activities based on non-formal education will be organized, such as: debates, simulation games, forum theater, image theater, play activities, field roles, team building, intercultural nights, cultural activities and reflections.

When & Where: 03.07 - 12.07.2021
(including travel days);
Oglinzi Camp (Neamt), Romania
Travel days: 3rd July and 12th July

Whom: Roma and non-Roma, young people aged between 16 and 25, disadvantaged, live in rural areas or marginal urban neighborhoods

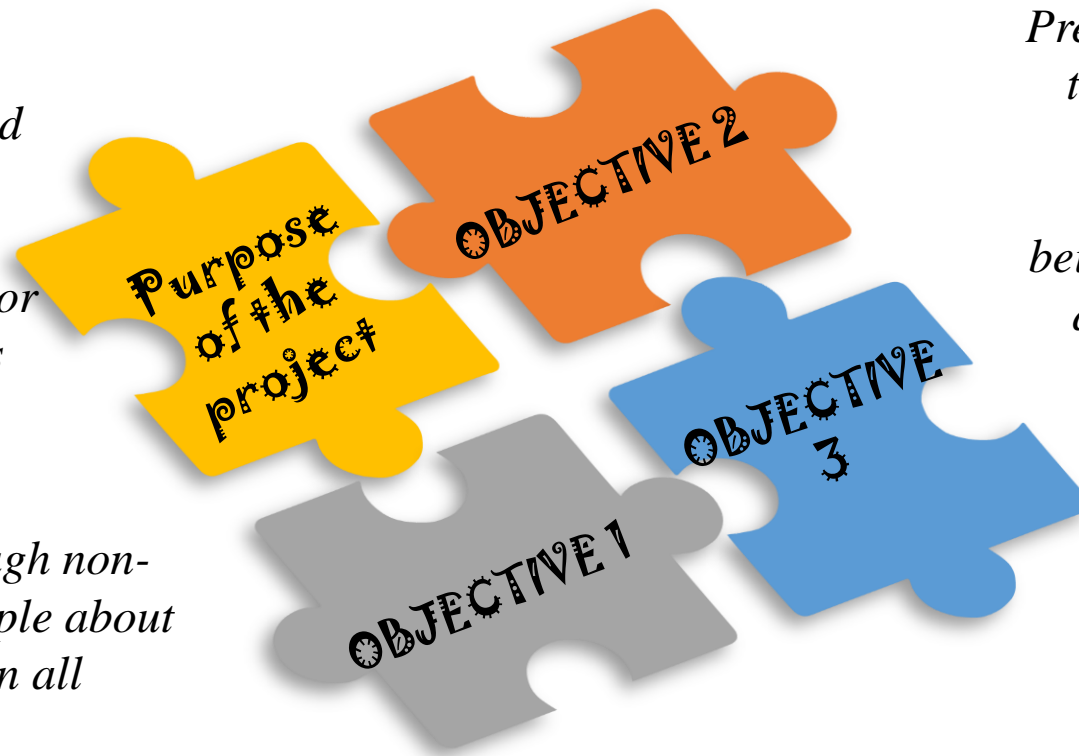
The PRO ROMA Association is a non-governmental organization in response to the urgent need for social inclusion of the Roma community.

•SUMMARY

The project "Action and reaction to bullying" was born from the desire of our young people to combat bullying, in all its forms, with the help of forum theater and image theater. The young people of the association realized that bullying affects more and more students and young people in the community and they wanted that through forum theater and image theater and other methods of non-formal education to find ways to help them stop being victims of bullying and change the mentality of those involved. The project aims to eliminate discrimination and promote attitudes of tolerance and empathy by involving participants from disadvantaged environments. Together, young people have the opportunity to work to achieve a common goal: staging a theater show.

The aim of our project is to help promote methods of informing and helping victims of bullying by including those affected by bullying due to their environment or origin, social and cultural status and / or ethnicity.

Development of knowledge through non-formal education of 36 young people about the phenomenon of bullying in all stages of the project.



Preparing the 36 young people to use the methods of forum theater and image theater in the 8 days of mobility, thus being able to use them independently during the dissemination period.

Promoting opportunities through the new Erasmus program in all phases of the project.



WHY



The project “Action and reaction against bullying” is a youth mobility and is addressed equally to people who have experienced / witnessed bullying in schools, as well as to disadvantaged groups from a social, economic or ethnic point of view, but also to people who were not affected by bullying. Thus, we want to create a balanced discussion environment and have different perspectives of the participants, helping the social inclusion of the disadvantaged.

We want to bring a change in awareness of the phenomenon of bullying and how we can act to help those abused.

All participants are young people who want to acquire new information and skills necessary for their personal development /professionals, being actively involved in all sessions that will take place during mobility and will develop their social skills, will understand the effects of bullying, will acquire skills and competencies in order to improve the effect and the occurrence of the phenomenon.

Young people will better understand the phenomenon of bullying. They will receive information and go through experiences that will open their eyes to the psychic effects of the phenomenon, because they will have to experiment through informal games and by building role-playing games (theater). This process of debate, of creation will highlight the characteristics of the characters in the plays that will determine young people to achieve a type of behavior that they or their colleagues have in bullying situations. Thus, young people will be aware of a type of behavior and thus will know how to react against this phenomenon.

TRANSPORTATION

Arrival: Iasi Airoport, the 3st of July

Departure: Iasi Airoport, 12th of July

You should take a flight to Iasi airport, because it is the main airport near our region and you will find planes from your country easily. About transportation from the airport we will inform you after collecting all participants' flight information, because we normally pick up the participants at the airport and bring them directly to the project location, all together, by a private bus. The cost of this private bus per participant is 15€, this price, including travel go and return to the airport. We believe that is a more than fair price for all these trips.

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

SPAIN – 360 EUR/participant

TURKEY – 275 EUR/participant

POLAND – 275 EUR/participant

BULGARIA– 275 EUR/participant

CROATIA – 275 EUR/participant

ROMÂNIA – 20 EUR/participant

Another option is the airport in Bucharest, after which the whole group of participants will be taken by a private bus, which will travel to the place where the participants will carry out their activity.

Please have in mind that from the total amount of grant/participant we will cover the transfers from Bucuresti/Iasi. This means that 50€ per participant will be kept for this purpose. Please discuss with the organizers and sending organization before buying the tickets.

Accommodation, food and materials during activity days are fully covered by Erasmus+ Programme.



REIMBURSEMENT

Reimbursement of travel costs will be done by bank transfer to your NGO as soon as you provide all necessary travel documents (invoice, ticket, boarding pass, etc) and provided full involvement in project activities is confirmed.

Travel expenses will be covered after collecting travel documents on condition that the participants use the cheapest ways of transportation and submitted original invoices for plane tickets, boarding passes, train and bus tickets. Private cars, Taxi and first class tickets will not be reimbursed.

Please keep the boarding passes from your airport check in as well. Reimbursement will be done in EURO, regardless of the currency indicated on your ticket and receipt/invoice.

For the reimbursement of the money, you have to bring us all original documents:

- *invoices,*
- *e-tickets,*
- *proof of payment (if you pay in cash you have to bring us the receipt, but if you pay online you have to bring us the bank statement)*
- *original boarding passes*

We strongly encourage you to buy flights that have the possibility to do online check-in and in this way you will be able to give us the return boarding passes before coming to Romania, without having to send its to us by post mail once back home. Of course, if for your airline is not possible to do it, you still need to send us the boarding passes by post mail after the project.

It is very important to have all your travel and financial documents with you (the same for every member of the team), otherwise the reimbursement is NOT possible!

Please, check the VALIDITY of the passports before the departure – Passport must be valid at least for 6 (six) months.

Of course, if you want you can stay 1-2 days before/after the project in order to visit us, Iasi city, but you have to pay by yourself for those extra days.

The OGLINZI leisure center is located 4 km from the city of Tg. Neamt, the mountain area, behind the Citadel of Neamt, belonging to the Ministry of Youth and Sport.

Each room has its own bathroom (heating and hot water permanently with central heating), television in each room, internet without wireless, conference room.

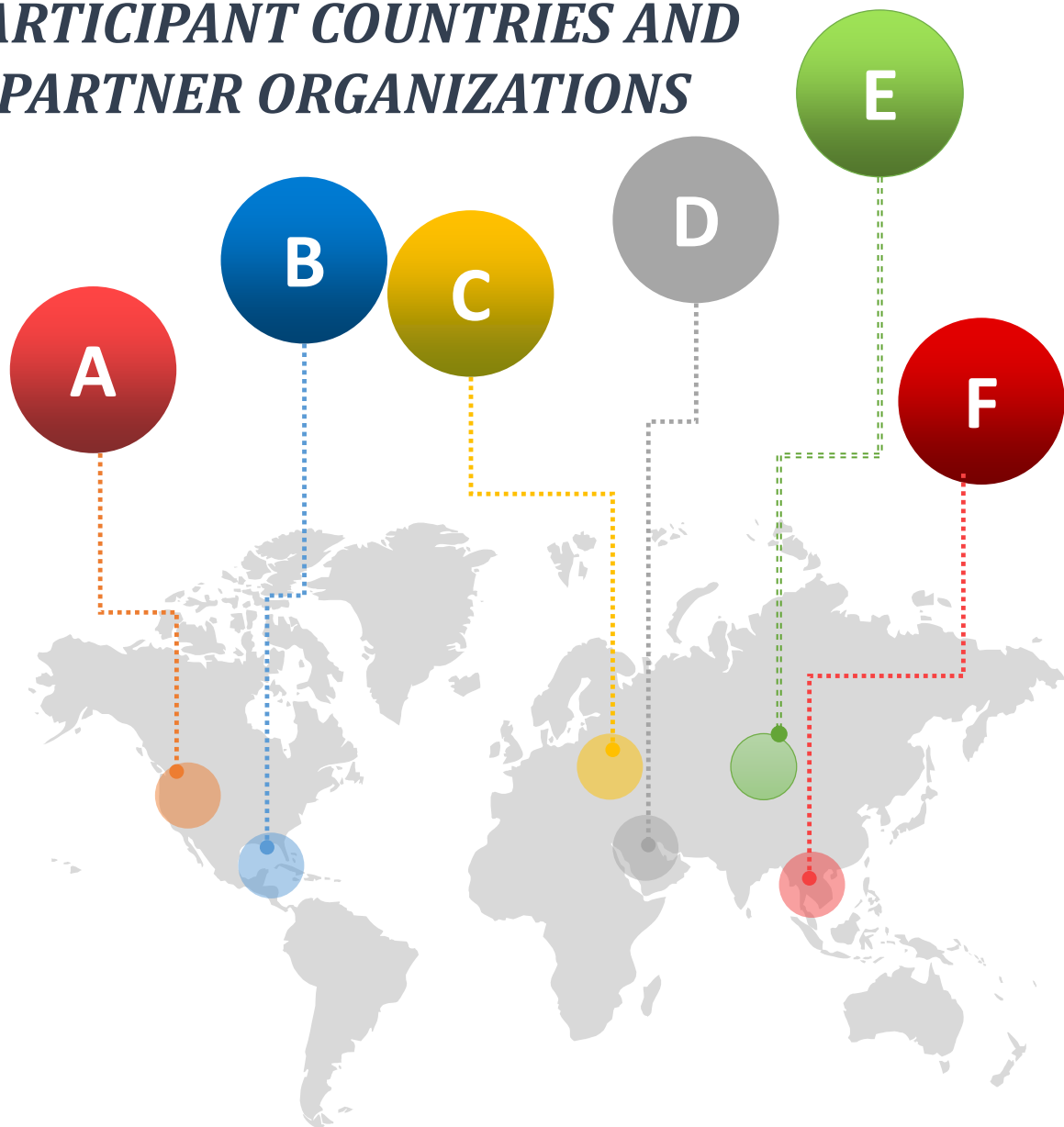
Tourist routes that can be seen following an agreement:

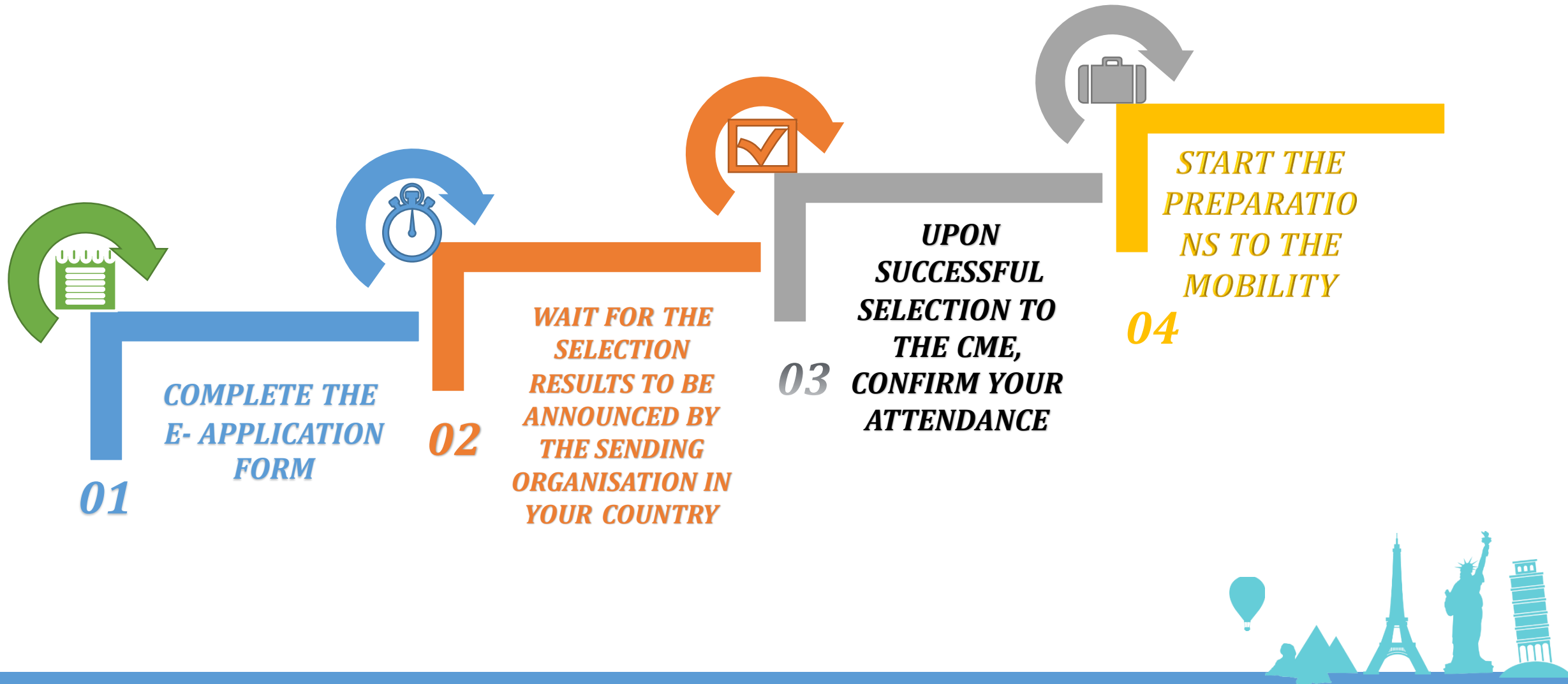

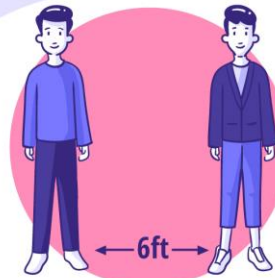


COVID-19 PREVENTION
