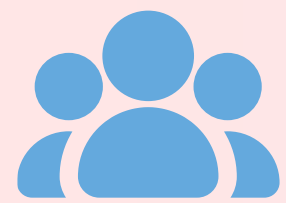


WHEN & WHERE:

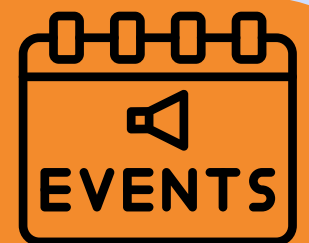

SUMMARY

PURPOSE OF THE PROJECT

The aim of the project is to train young people with limited opportunities in the field of social media to develop the skills necessary to create high-quality content that has an impact in highlighting social issues.

OBJECTIVE 1

Empowering participants with skills and competencies in using social media tools, enabling them to become more active and involved in their communities.



OBJECTIVE 2

Promoting intercultural collaboration by using digital platforms to improve teamwork and communication.

OBJECTIVE 3

Developing creativity and critical thinking by involving the 36 participants in creating creative social media content that allows them to solve problems in a new and effective way.

ACCOMMODATION

All participants will be accommodated in the Oglinzi camp, in rooms for 2-3 people, there is the possibility of mixing the whole group in one room, mixed international, but not gender.

HOW TO GET HERE

The nearest airport is Iasi, from where we will arrange Transfers to oglinzi camp. Minimum 2 transfers depending on arrival times.

The nearest train station is pascani, from where we will arrange pick-ups.

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The Oglinzi Camp is located in the village of Oglinzi, Neamț County, near a centuries-old forest steeped in history, behind Neamț Fortress, 4 km from the town of Târgu Neamț. The Oglinzi Camp belongs to the Ministry of Youth and Sports.

The camp has a capacity of 150 places and consists of the main cabin (the former Carol Hotel of the resort - 1894), four villas, and a cottage.

FACTS

- This is youth exchange and the participation in all the sessions of each day are mandatory.
- Each group will have to present the country during the intercultural evening, therefore please bring with you specific products and promotional materials.
- Each participant should have the European health insurance card or private insurance during the stay in Romania.
- All national groups will stay in contact with the sending NGO who's role is properly prepare the participants for this youth exchange.
- The activities during the exchange will be carried out using specific non-formal, interactive and participatory learning methodologies (individual reflective, group reflective, individual work and working groups, simulation games, visits, presentations, team work, cultural evenings).
- If any participant have any special diet that affects your health or have a different alimentary option, must communicate in the personal application before coming to Romania





MORE FACTS

Each national group should travel together with the group leader.

Underaged participants need the approval from parents to participate (a specific form will be given to them to sign).

Oglinzi camp is located in a mountainous area, and october is the beginning of the cold season in romania, when colder rains may occur, so we recommend that you have appropriate clothing, suitable for slightly lower temperatures.
